READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING PROJECT.

RECOMMENDED FOR: Railings, fences, patio furniture, house trim, boats (above the waterline).

NOT RECOMMENDED FOR: Decks or high traffic areas, cladding or rough-sawn surfaces.

PREVIOUSLY FINISHED SURFACES: For best adhesion, surfaces must be clean, dry and free of wax, grease, oil, shellac, lacquer, mildew and polishes. Remove wax with a wax stripper, shellac with a paint stripper, and mildew with a solution of up to 10% household bleach and tap water. Old finishes in poor condition must be removed. Sand to obtain a smooth surface. Remove all sanding dust using a vacuum or cloth dampened with mineral turps

STAINED OR PAINTED WOOD: Follow manufacturer's direction for application of stain or paint. Make certain surface is thoroughly dry before applying Zinsser Manne Spar Varnish. Refer to manufacturer's label for dry times.

UNFINISHED SURFACE PREPARATION: Sand smooth using 120-150 grit sandpaper and remove all sanding dust. If a filler or putty is used, make sure that it does not contain wax and allow enough time for it to dry thoroughly.

APPLICATION TIPS: Use adequate ventilation at all times. Do not apply in direct sunlight. Apply at temperatures above 13°C and below 32°C. Slower dry times may result from applications on hard exotic woods with high oil content, use of stain or sealer, or periods of high humidity and/or low temperatures. Use care when applying over white or pastel paints or stains as discolouration may occur. Do not dilute. Test Zinsser Marine Spar Varnish in an inconspicuous area before beginning. Testing is particularly important when applying over paints or stains as the appearance of these products may change slightly when an oil-based finish is applied.

APPLICATION: Stir thoroughly before and during use. To prevent bubbles in the finish, DO NOT SHAKE. Do not over-brush or apply with a roller. Apply using a good quality, natural bristle brush, or applicator. Allow finish to dry 4 hours and then re-coat. Lower temperatures and/or higher humidity may cause slower dry times. Re-coat only when previous coats have dried clear and feel

hard. (Should no longer feel tacky to the touch.) If a coat has dried more than 12 hours, lightly sand before re-coating. A minimum of 3 coats is recommended. Allow finish to dry 24 hours before light use. Wait 3 days before subjecting surface to normal usage.

CLEAN-UP: For easy clean-up, use paint thinner or mineral turps.
