Varnish leaves no brush marks and adds a warm, golden glow to your projects.

READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING PROJECT.

RECOMMENDED FOR: Furniture, trim, cabinets, wood doors and panelling.

NOT RECOMMENDED FOR: Exterior surfaces, linoleum, vinyl or glazed tiles and metal. For wood floors, use Zinsser[®] Ultra Thick Floor Finish.


PREVIOUSLY FINISHED SURFACES: For best adhesion, surfaces must be clean, dry, and free of old finishes, dust, dirt, oils or other foreign matter. Old finishes, in poor condition must be removed. Sand to obtain a smooth surface. Do not use steel wool as rust may develop after finish has been applied. Remove all sanding dust using a vacuum or cloth dampened with mineral turps.

STAINED OR PAINTED WOOD: Follow manufacturer's direction for application of stain or paint. Make certain surface is thoroughly dry before applying Zinsser Clear Varnish. Refer to manufacturer's label for dry times. For best results, use a Zinsser® Wood Stain.

UNFINISHED SURFACE PREPARATION: Sand using 150-220 grit sandpaper and remove all sanding dust using a rag lightly dampened with mineral turps, or vacuum. If a filler or putty is used, make sure that it does not contain wax and allow for enough time to dry thoroughly.

APPLICATION TIPS: Use adequate ventilation at all times. Apply at temperatures above 13°C and below 32°C. Slower dry times may result from applications on redwood, cedar or woods with high oil content, use of stain or sealer, or periods of high humidity and/or low temperatures. To prevent bubbles in the finish, do not over-brush, shake container or apply with a roller. Zinsser Clear Varnish has a slight amber cast. Test Zinsser Clear Varnish in an inconspicuous area. Testing is particularly important when applying over paints or stains as the appearance of these products may change slightly when an oil-based finish is applied.

APPLICATION: Stir thoroughly before and during use. To prevent bubbles in the finish, DO NOT SHAKE CONTAINER. Apply using a good quality, synthetic bristle brush, foam brush or applicator. Allow finish to dry 8 hours and then re-coat. Lower temperatures and/or higher humidity may cause slower dry



DRY TIME: A minimum of 3 coats is recommended. Allow finish to dry 24 hours before light use. Wait 3 days before subjecting surface to normal usage.

CLEAN-UP: For easy clean-up, use paint thinner or mineral turps.

COVERAGE: 27 to 53 m² per 3.78 L
