READ ALL DIRECTIONS REFORE REGINNING PROJECT

RECOMMENDED FOR: Exterior wood surfaces. Ideal for: railings, fences, patio furniture, house trim, boats (above the waterline).

NOT RECOMMENDED FOR: Decks or high traffic areas, cladding or rough-sawn surfaces.

PREVIOUSLY FINISHED SURFACES: For best adhesion, surfaces must be clean, dry and free of wax, grease, oil, shelta, lacquer, midwe and poishes. Remove wax with a wax stripper, sheltac with a paint stripper, and middew with a solution of up to 10% household bleach and tap water. Old finishes in poor condition must be removed. Sand to obtain a smooth surface. Remove all sanding dust using a vacuum or cloth dampened with mineral turns.

STAINED OR PAINTED WOOD: Follow manufacturer's direction for application of stain or paint. Make certain surface is thoroughly dry before applying Zinsser Exterior Varnish. Refer to manufacturer's label for dry times.

UNFINISHED SURFACE PREPARATION: Sand smooth using 120-150 grit sandpaper and remove all sanding dust. If a filler or putty is used, make sure that it does not contain wax and allow enough time for it to dry

APPLICATION TIPS: Use adequate ventilation at all times. Do not apply in direct sunlight. Apply at temperatures above 1976 and below 32°C. Slower dry times may result from applications on hard exotic woods, use of stain or sealer, or periods of high humidify and/or low temperatures. Use care when applying over white or pastel paints or stains as discolouration may occur. Do not dilute. Test Zinsser Exterior Varnish in an inconspicuous area before beginning. Testing is particularly important when applying over paints or stains as the anormation end or mortular may chance slightly when an oil-based flinish is anoilied.

APPLICATION: Stir thoroughly before and during use. Apply using a good quality, natural bristle brush, or applicator. To prevent bubbles in the finish, do not over-brush, shake container or apply with a roller. All reliables to the finish to dry 4 hours and then ne-coat. Lower temperatures and/or higher humidity may cause slower dry times. Re-coat only when previous coats have dired clear and feel hard. (Should no longer feel tacky to the touch) if the coat has dried more than 12 hours, lightly sand before re-coating. A minimum of 3 coats is recommended. Allow finish to dry 24 hours before light use. Wait 3 days before subjecting surface to normal research.

CLEAN UP: For easy clean-up, use paint thinner or mineral turps.

COVERAGE: 7 to 8 m² per 473 mL
